MDG's and Progress - 1

- Goal 1: Eradicate Extreme Poverty and Hunger – lagging economic growth
- Goal 2: Achieve Universal Primary Education – more attending / quality ?
- Goal 3: Promote Gender Equality and Empower Women: primary education gender parity in half of countries

MDG's and Progress - 2

- Goal 4: Reduce Child Mortality under 5 mortality rate down 47% (need more)
- Goal 5: Improve Maternal Health nearly halved since 1990 (need more)
- Goal 6: Combat HIV/AIDS, Malaria and other diseases – reduction in new infections of all diseases (still threats)

MDG's and Progress - 3

 Goal 7: Ensure Environmental Sustainability – CO2 emissions down / forests shrinking / water & sanitation problems

 Goal 8: Global Partnership for Development – short of target

Mixed Record

Good Start

 SRI and CSR can help overcome part of MDG deficits

SRI – What is it?

Three Main Areas:

1) Environment and Sustainability

2) Labour Practices

3) Community Investing (reducing inequality)

SRI in Africa: Kiva

 Microfinance – brings lenders and loantakers together

- Over 1, 000, 000 lenders
- (over 4, 000 lenders joined last week)
- USD 524, 272, 950 in loans
- (over USD 2.5 m last week)
- 98.97% Repayment Rate

Kiva Fund Administration

Works with lenders in the field

- 238 Field Partners
- 450 Volunteers
- 73 Countries (many in Africa)

Kiva Lending Cycle

Community Investing (Microfinance)

- People (can lend as little as USD 25):
 - Choose a borrower
 - Make a loan
 - Get repaid principle only
 - (Repeat)


CSR – What is it?

• Corporate Responsibility can be defined as how companies address the social, environmental and economic impacts of their operations and so help to meet our sustainable development goals.

(UK government definition very typical)
